

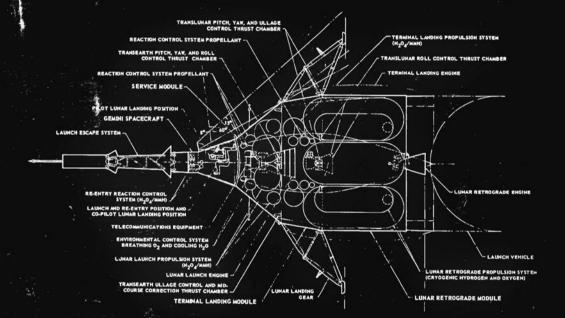

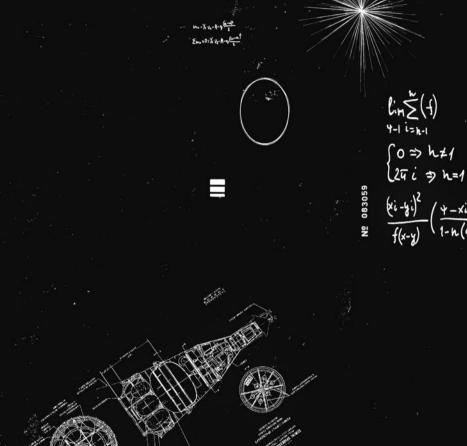


/Project_Concept

/Forging_The_Order

The original forging members of The Order are just like you. They are frequent users in the cryptoverse, just regular people discovering, learning, and earning. And like you, they have been victims to scam tokens, rug pulls, and sub-par projects.

One day, the group decided to set out and create a new standard of alt-coin. They chose to elevate the bar on branding, messaging, art, and community. The Red Order was then formed with the simple mission to create the most premium token experience in the alt-coin market.

It is our goal to deliver quality concepts and art that our members would actually want to own. And to use the diverse specialties within the core team, which includes an exceptional branding/design team, legal counselors, successful entrepreneurs, and campaign strategists, to propel the visibility and legitimacy of such a project to heights not yet seen within the community.

We don't believe in rug pulls or scam tactics. We don't settle for mediocre design work or branding. And we're not here to copy pasta. We are here to chart our own path and build a community that can pride itself on the quality foundation laid before it.

The Red Order will rise above the rest. That is its destiny.



/Tokenomics_&_Transparency

Our tokenomics are straight forward. We decided on a 500 billion initial total supply, all minted at launch. No one will then be able to create any more tokens after the initial launch.

45% of that supply will be allocated to a marketing/project development wallet. This wallet will not be used to reward the current core members of the project. It will only be used to further the development of the project, which can include on-boarding NEW team members, paying for various audits and exchange listings, paying for marketing fees and sponsorships, covering giveaways and prizes, and much more. You will hold us accountable for our spending. The wallet address will be provided to the community, available for anyone to track the funds, and all transactions will receive an explanation from the core team.

The remaining 85% of the tokens are pooled as liquidity into SushiSwap.

A 2% burn on every transaction will also be in effect. So 2% per TXN will be sent to the 0x0...000ded wallet, forever removed from circulation. Holding, therefore, makes each token more valuable over time.

Another 2% per TXN will be sent into the marketing wallet explained above. We don't want to beg our community for donations. As the Overlords, it's our responsibility to drive project progress, and this ensures that we do that from our own funds, not yours.

Finally, another 2% per TXN will be sent back into the main contract deployment wallet. This will allow us to maintain tokens that we can pool back into liquidity, or create pools on centralized exchanges, or even set up a protocol for community voting where holding members can decide what to do with the tokens.

Transparency will be our biggest weapon against FUD. We will aim to explain our decisions and allocation of funds to the best of our abilities. We realize that trust is difficult in this space, but our goal here is to help redefine community expectations, and we'll do that through our honesty.

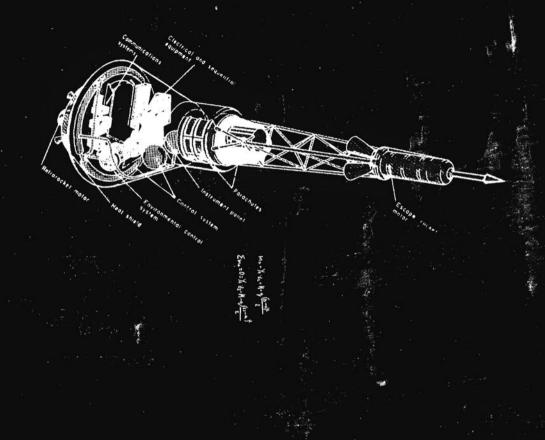

/Project_Legitimacy

When we set out to create The Red Order, we wanted a legitimate stake in crypto history. We have taken steps to help address the many worries that daily users contend with.

That means no token pre-sale, no team tokens, and no pre launch token allocations. Members of the core team will BUY IN at the same time as the general public, ensuring a perfectly fair launch.

We have also onboarded an exceptional PR firm who's objective will be to break through the noise and give The Red Order proper media coverage. They will help spread awareness about the progress of the project and keep us in the spotlight. This is crucial as we set out to take over the space.

We have also created multiple business entities that each play a role within the project. The LLCs will ensure that certain assets remain protected in any case of trouble. It also cements our position as a business oriented project.

These steps make it difficult for this project to rug or exit scam. We have made our identities public to those who are on board and guiding us. We cannot run from anyone, and we don't plan to. Our anonymity online is simply for the safety of our core team. It is not an evasion from any agency that whichs to reach us.



/Future_Progress

When conceptualizing for The Red Order, we wanted to build a role playing experience to keep the community engaged and to lay the foundation for massive future growth. The creation of the 11 Overlords and their characters is only the beginning. As members of The Red Order, you will follow these story-lines and learn more about the origins and intentions of each character. Each character will then receive its own specialized NFT drop containing art and assets that you will actually want to own.

We're experimenting with various mediums, including AR, 3D, animations, and more, to bring new and exciting experiences to our members. Our vision is to build a universe for everyone to experience, and potentially own a piece of. Not to mention the character developments in place that can lead to the creation of comic strips, games, and maybe even movies.

We've spent the most time on developing the brand, which we believe to be the backbone of this project, and we plan to leverage that to stand out as the premium token in this space.
